AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF WAYNESBORO, FRANKLIN COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, REPEALING IN ITS ENTIRETY ORDINANCE NO. 1038 OF THE BOROUGH OF WAYNESBORO, BEING AN ORDINANCE IMPOSING A PER CAPITA TAX

WHEREAS, The Borough Council of the Borough of Waynesboro, Franklin County, Pennsylvania, deems it to be in the best interest and the general welfare of the citizens and residents of the Borough to repeal Ordinance No. 1038 which imposed a Per Capita Tax upon each Borough resident, 18 years of age or older.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED, by the Mayor and Borough Council of the Borough of Waynesboro, Franklin County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained as follows:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 1038 of the Borough of Waynesboro, Franklin County, Pennsylvania, being an Ordinance imposing a Per Capita Tax upon each Borough resident, 18 years of age or older, is hereby repealed in its entirety effective January 1, 2017.

SECTION 2. Repealer: All provisions of previous ordinances of the Borough of Waynesboro, which are contrary to this Ordinance, are expressly repealed.

SECTION 3: Savings Clause: In all other respects, the ordinances of the Borough of Waynesboro shall remain as previously enacted and ordained.

SECTION 4: Severability. If any word, phrase, sentence, part, section, subsection, or other portion of this ordinance or any application thereof to any person or circumstance is declared void, unconstitutional, or invalid for any reason, then such word, phrase, sentence, part, section, subsection, or other portion, or the proscribed application thereof, shall be severable and the remaining provisions of this ordinance and all applications thereof, not having been declared void, unconstitutional, or invalid, shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 5: Effective Date: This Ordinance shall take effect immediately.
